Even if the park doesn't close, I face a variety of other problem (unfair rules, large rent increases, unaddressed maintenance issues).
(In your third paragraph, identify how you want to see the issue solved) Tell your representative what the solution is to your issue, how it solves the problem, and why you support it.
<i>For example</i> : One solution to all of these problems is for us to own both our homes and the land. In Minnesota, there are ten resident-owned communities, but this is out of over 900 parks. Some states allow residents to make an offer any time their park is for sale. I support a bill (House File 112 / Senate File 1282) that requires the park owner to give us 60 days' notice before they sell the park, so we can put in an offer.
(State what you are asking the legislator to support or oppose) Tell your representative you want them to support the bill and ask them to give you a response.
